

*Records of District Level Workshop on
Rastriya Swasthya Bima Yogna –Rajnandgoan Chhattisgarh*

A one day workshop was organized at Rajnandgoan, District Rajnandgoan Chhattisgarh with an objective to sensitize and train the ground level functionaries in District Rajnandgoan on their roles and responsibilities in the implementation of Rastriya Swasthya Bima Yogna.

The workshop started with welcome address by the Chief Medical and Health officer,

Dr K Madan Gopal, GTZ consultant made a detailed presentation covering all aspects of the programme.

TPA Mr. Ajeet Pratap Emeditec then explained the whole process of enrollment including Key Management System and the role the field key officer will play. Dr Madan Gopal, further detailed on how to help TPA in making road map/ enrollment schedule and how to help in mobilizing beneficiaries during the enrollment process. He highlighted the role to be played by Field Key officer and requested all the participants to start mouth publicity about this scheme in their institutions.

Mr. Shailender Singh explained the DKMA software. DKMA and FKO cards were issued to the CMHO and the District Data Assistant was deputed to understand the working DKMA software and was asked by CMHO to be in touch with Mr Shailender Singh.

The Chief Medical and Health officer assured all help and support for making this programme successful. Two blocks were identified for start of the programme and the TPA were requested to initiate the process from there. The TPA and the Block Medical officers interacted afterwards to chalk out further plans.

This was followed by video on enrollment process and transaction process.

In the end, the TPA and consultant tried successfully to answer questions and queries from the participants.

The workshop ended in a positive note.

Following the workshop the TPA and the BMOs had separate meeting to chalk out further action plan for Smart card enrollment.
